Dear Parents / Carers,

As you are aware the country has now gone in to lockdown. At this moment in time the schools are to remain open.

However, I would like to ask for your support in the following changes to ensure extra protection for our school community:

Please do not enter the school building unless you absolutely have to – phone the school for enquiries or to make an appointment for a phone conversation with your child's class teacher.

Please put dinner money, in an envelope clearly labelled, with your child's name and class and send it in to school with your child. If you wish to pay for a block of dinners or to pay by cheque, then this will be perfectly acceptable. (Cheques made payable to 'Wellesbourne Primary and Nursery School') Try to put the right amount of money in the envelope so that the office staff do not have to handle large quantities of cash and return change. You will immediately receive a receipt for your money but there may be a delay in you receiving your change.

Visitors will not be allowed on to the school premises and any essential visitors to the school will be asked to wear face coverings if there is a risk of contact.

Please continue to support by wearing face coverings on the school grounds and maintain social distancing. Please limit the number of adults coming on to the grounds with your child to one.

Your child will immediately wash their hands when they come in to school and are in the routine of doing this throughout the day.

ALL extra-curricular activities have been cancelled – we are advised that we should not run after school clubs. However, this does NOT include Breakfast Club which will run as normal.

Please can I remind you or your child develops symptoms you should isolate and book a test. If you develop symptoms, please keep all member of your household at home until you receive the results of your test. If you test positive inform the school as soon as possible and then isolate your household for 14 days from the start of the symptoms.

With your support we have been incredibly lucky and have not have to send many children home – unlike most of our counterparts. Please continue to support these measures and help our community to get out of this pandemic.
