#### **CURRICULUM CORNER**

### This Week's Subject: Art



Through our Art curriculum we aim to spark our children's creativity and imagination, enabling them to respond to the world around them in a special way. We encourage pupils to engage with activities in a personal way through the use of skills and techniques which are practised and developed

from EYFS all the way through to Year 6. In our approach to the curriculum, we engage in a five-step process (research, practise, plan, make and evaluate) which supports pupils in making decisions and choices which are personal to them.

Year 6 have been researching the impact of plastic on the environment and the "Great Wave of Kangagawa" by Hokusai. This has formed the inspiration for their unit around 3D art where pupils will work collaboratively to create a sculpture made from recycled materials. 

#### Dear Parent/Carer,

The 'It's Your Child's life' course is coming to Wellesbourne Primary School on Thursday

22nd September 2022 to help you help your child thrive at school. This course runs for 6 weeks for between 60 and 90 minutes just after you drop your child off at the start of the school day at 9am.

As parents, you have a massive influence on your child's learning and development. The course gives you a real insight into what your child will be learning at school and how they are being taught. Each week you'll receive lots of practical tips and ideas as to how to help your child develop skills in reading, writing, maths, confidence and resilience. You will be given a booklet full of resources and ideas for fun games to play with your child at home which helps them embed what they have learnt in school. The course is also a good chance to meet other parents and share ideas and experiences with them. Parents who have done the course say they have noticed a big difference in their child. Schools have told us that those children of parents who have been on the course have really grown in confidence as they meet new challenges in Reception and Year 1. The course is brilliant if you're interested in becoming a TA too!

The course is open to all parents/grandparents/carers of Reception. However, places are limited at this time to 10 parents so be quick to respond! Don't worry if you can't make all 6 sessions as a grandparent/friend could stand in for you if needed.
