CURRICULUM CORNER

This Week's Subject: Design Technology

In DT, children have the opportunity to make and create a range of products to meet a specific design brief. Like in Art, our children follow a five-step process to develop their skills and understanding.

They conduct **research** around existing products and techniques, **practise** key skills to experiment effective techniques, **plan** their work to refine their ideas, **make** a final piece and then reflect on their work through **evaluation**.
