Due to such low attendance this week, none of our classes have achieved Champions Breakfast.






CURRICULUM CORNER

This Week's Subject: Reading

As part of our Reading Curriculum, pupils from Reception to Year 6 participate in guided reading sessions each week. This allows them to read in a small group with an adult and talk about the text.

After these sessions, children will have a chance to show their understanding by completing an independent task putting their skills into action. In doing so, pupils are developing a wide range of skills which support them in the understanding and appreciation of reading. Children learn the acronym 'VIPERS' Vocabulary, Inference, Predication, Explanation, Retrieval and Summary (Sequencing in KS1) and consider their responses to questions using these as a support. To support your children at home with this, have a look at our website for examples of questions you can use.
