This Week's Subject: Music

Pupils from Y1-6 are taught music each week by our specialist teacher, Miss Parr. This allows them to build upon their prior learning and develop their skills over time. Our pupils have experience of a range of music and learn about different genres. They have opportunities to sing and appreciate music, as well as learning aspects of composition.
