THIS WEEK IN PSHE

This term in PSHE we are looking at Health and Wellbeing. This week, we have focused on physical and emotional changes as we grow, as well as personal hygiene. We have also began to talk to the children about the upcoming transition to their new year group and new class.



Year 1 Phonics

This week in Phonics, Year 1 have been looking at alternative sounds for graphemes.

We have looked at 'ea' making a short 'e' sound. This can be seen in words such as 'bread', 'breakfast', 'treadmill' and 'head'.

We have also looked at 'y' making the short 'igh' sound. This can be seen in words such as 'fly', 'sky', 'reply' and 'try'.

CURRICULUM CORNER

This Week's Subject: Design Technology (DT)

In DT, children have the opportunity to research, practise skills, plan and make a range of products meeting the requirements of a design brief. They then reflect on this learning to evaluate their project and consider changes they may make in the future. Our DT lessons incorporate a range of areas, including Structures and Mechanisms, Food Technology, Electricity and Textiles.

Year 6 have been working hard on a range of Design Technology skills! Over the past few weeks, they have focused on Food Technology, making a three-course meal from scratch (and even doing the washing up!).



They have also focused on their Electricity unit, which involved creating a battery-operated fairground ride. Thank you to the parents who assisted with this!
