CURRICULUM CORNER

This Week's Subject: Science

At Wellesbourne, scientific enquiry is at the core of our science lessons from EYFS to Year 6.
Our intention is for our children to develop an intrinsic desire to question the way the world around them works. We want our children to remember more, understand more and do more. Science is a unique opportunity for children to explore, discover and investigate the world around them.

We encourage our children to understand how science can be used to explain what is occurring, predict how things will behave, and analyse causes.

In Nursery, we have followed the children's interest in dinosaurs by providing pretend dinosaur bones for them to compare and match. They've found out about fossils using books and video clips and they've even made pretend fossils from salt dough!

Mrs Abley will be starting her Maternity Leave during the summer holidays - we look forward to bringing you more baby news in September. Good luck, Mrs Abley!


Reading Recommendation
