Year One Phonics

This week in Phonics, Year 1 have started to learn Phase 5 sounds! We have been learning the following sounds: 'ay' (play, stay) 'ou' (cloud, proud) 'ie' (tie, pie) 'ea' (seat, each) Can you think of any other words containing these sounds?

CURRICULUM CORNER

This Week's Subject: Writing

In Writing, children from Reception to Year 6 develop their learning by exploring a key text which immerses them into the text type. They build on their prior knowledge and work on the key skills which will support them to produce their own writing. They then put these into practice by planning their work which they then go on to write and edit. These steps allow our children to become confident writers as well as introducing them to a wide range of books.

In Year 2, pupils have been reading 'The Night Gardener' by Jan Brothers. They were superb at reading a text and identifying examples of features including alliteration, similes and expanded noun phrases. They can't wait to write their own narratives next week!
