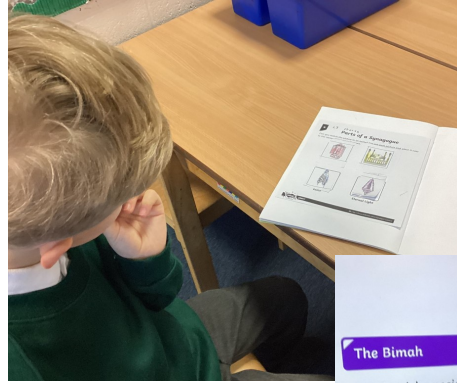

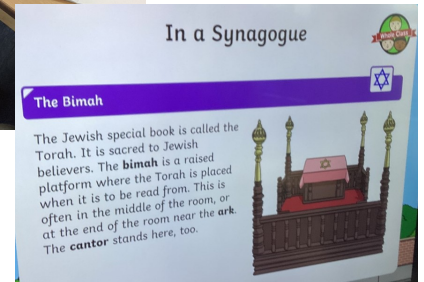
### Religious Education (RE)

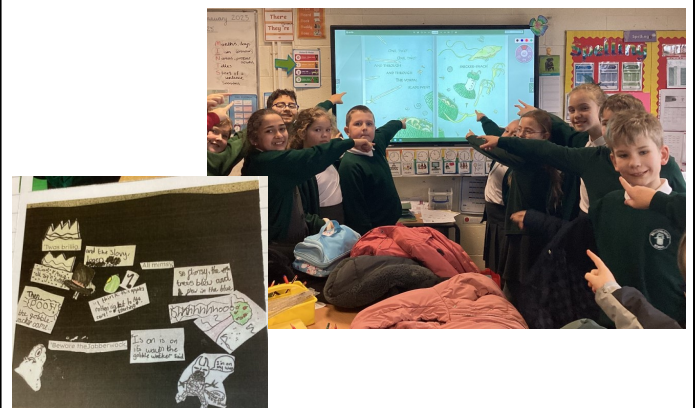
